About this opportunity:

As a Camp Counsellor at U+, you will lead daily camp activities, mentor youth, and ensure a safe, engaging, and memorable experience for all campers. You will facilitate programs that encourage creativity, teamwork, and personal growth while building positive relationships with participants and families.

Key responsibilities are as follows:

- Plan, organize, and lead engaging activities such as team-building, arts and crafts, STEM projects, and outdoor games.
- Implement structured daily schedules that promote skill-building, creativity, and fun.
- Supervise campers to maintain a safe, inclusive, and supportive environment.
- Address behavioral challenges constructively and provide positive emotional support.
- Communicate effectively with campers, parents, and staff to ensure smooth program operations.
- Collaborate with fellow counsellors to design and deliver innovative, inclusive programming.
- Promote teamwork, leadership, and cultural awareness among campers.
- Ensure compliance with safety procedures, camp policies, and First Aid/CPR protocols.
- Assist with special events that support youth empowerment, mental wellness, and diversity initiatives.
- Participate in staff training and contribute to a cohesive, high-performing camp team.



- Support the Camp Director with daily operations, setup, and general camp logistics.
- Deliver day camps (e.g., March Break Camp, Weekend Camp, and Summer Camp) and other virtual and in-person educational programs across the Greater Toronto Area.

Requirements:

- Enthusiasm, creativity, and a genuine passion for youth development.
- Ability to work weekends and summer program schedules.
- Candidates must be between 15-30 years of age, a Canadian citizen/permanent resident/refugee protection status, and have a valid SIN.
- A valid Standard First Aid with CPR-C certification and a clear Vulnerable Sector Check are required prior to start date (not reimbursed).

Assets:

- Experience in STEM programming, arts instruction, sports leadership, or outdoor education.
- Background in youth mentorship, coaching, or community engagement.
- Knowledge of inclusive practices supporting diversity and accessibility.
- Fluency in multiple languages (reading, writing, speaking, and listening).
- Access to a vehicle and a valid Ontario driver's license.

This is a fully in-person position. Salary ranges from \$18–26/hour, dependent on experience, skills, education, and role.
